ARTIST RULES

Conference Center - Ohkay Owingeh, New Mexico

July 6 -7, 2024

- I. **Artist personal Information:** Please complete all information in this section. Also, include a copy of your CIB. No applications will be accepted without your CIB.
- II. **Classification:** Please select a classification for all types of artwork you will be entering for the show.
- III. **Booth Preference:** The booths measure 8 feet; we will provide tables and chairs for all booths. Booths will be located along the walls inside the conference center & in the west pre-function area. The 8ft booths will be in the center aisles inside the conference center & in the north pre-function area. **Only two (2) adult artists allowed per booth.**
- IV. **Booth Fees:** Booth fees are **Per Booth** not per artist, therefore the cost may be split between two artists if it is a shared booth. Full payment must be enclosed with your signed application signifying that you have read these rules. We accept, money orders and credit card payments. Do not send cash or personal checks. Cash and most credit cards will be accepted if you pay at our office. Please make all payment payable to: **Ohkay Hotel Casino. Only two (2) adult artists allowed per booth.**
- V. **Application Deadline:** Completed applications and payment must be received in our office by 3:00 p.m. Monday, July 1, 2024.
- VI. **Selection of Qualified Applicants:** Booths will be assigned after applications are reviewed by Ohkay Hotel Casino Banquet's Staff members. If your application is rejected, you will be notified and your refund will be sent within 90 working days after the show. Applicants will be notified of acceptance or rejection via e-mail or phone prior to July 2, 2024.
- VII. **Cancellations:** If you have been accepted for the show and cannot attend, you will receive a refund within 90 days after the show, provided you notify us in writing by July 1, 2024.
- VIII. **Rules of Selling:** All items must be hand crafted by the artist who is listed on the application and must be signed, stamped, tagged, or labeled. No artwork created more than two years ago may be shown or offered for sale. Ohkay Hotel Casino has firm standards designed to protect the integrity and prestige of the show for all artists and to insure the general public of quality Native American hand-crafted items. All artists are considered professional, and therefore, are encouraged to have business cards to provide to all buyers.
- IX. **Transactions:** All sales and transactions between the artist and buyer are to be honored, a detailed receipt must accompany all transactions. Please honor any transactions that you make. Furthermore, all artists are required to guarantee their workmanship. If the show coordinator receives any complaints about vendors who do not honor their transaction, the vendor will not be accepted into future shows. It is not the responsibility of the Ohkay Hotel Casino to become involved in transactions between buyers and sellers; however, we will do so if the need arises.

X. **Not Allowed In The 2024 Indigenous Arts and Crafts Fair:**

- No German silver, nickel silver or liquid silver. (handmade liquid silver is acceptable)
- No plastic imitation stones.
- No stoneware, wheel-thrown, ceramic pottery, or commercial clay pottery.
- No publication or printed materials. This includes books, produced postcards or poster prints.
- No commercial, machine-made or stamped products may be sold.

2. **Other items allowed in The 2024 Indigenous Arts and Crafts Fair:**

- Piñon Nuts
- Hopi Piki Bread
- Pueblo Oven Bread
- Pies & Cookies
- Parched Corn

Other food items can NOT be sold in the Arts & Crafts indoor booths. **Food Handler cards & proof of insurance are required and must be displayed.**

Since The Ohkay Hotel Casino wants to protect the reputation and integrity of our show and of the artists who participate in it, **we will enforce the rules.** Misrepresentations of any artwork will result in expulsion from the show and prohibit the exhibitor's re-admission for three years.

Please Note: The Ohkay Hotel Casino is not responsible for any injuries, accidents, lost or stolen items, water damage or any hardships due to weather conditions.
